Eligibility Requirements

TEEN

- Is between 13–17 years of age as of 1/1/2025
- Is single, not married, has never been married is not pregnant & has never given birth

MISS

- Is between 18–28 years of age as of 1/1/2025
- Is single or divorced, is not pregnant & has never given birth

MS

- Is 29+ as of 1/1/2025
- Is single, divorced, with or without children

MRS

- Is 18+ as of 1/1/2025
- Is legally married to her spouse
- Is a citizen or permanent resident married to a U.S. citizen

ALL DIVISIONS

 Is a U.S. citizen, or has been granted permanent residency by the United States.

2. Is a resident, works, or goes to school in the state they are competing.

3. Is a natural born female.

4. Has never appeared nude in photographs or film

This is your chance to let your inner fashionista shine while showcasing your American pride! Costumes can reflect National or State characteristics.







Wardrobe Requirements

FITNESS/SWIM

TEENS – Select any style athletic clothing & athletic shoes

MISS/MS/MRS - Select any style swimsuit & heels. NO THONGS ALLOWED! Bottoms must provide adequate coverage!





EVENING GOWN

You will need a floor length formal dress, any style, any color. Select a dress that flatters your figure, complexion, and makes you feel beautiful!





Areas of Competition

25% of score Round Robin 4 minutes, 3 judges

25% of score Onstage presentation



INTERVIEW

Judging Criteria: Content of Judges Bio, Knowledge, Perception, Self Expression, Spontaneity and Personality will be evaluated. Also important are the Use of Vocabulary, Voice, Appearance and Grooming. Here are some things the Judges will be thinking about: How well did the Contestant answer the questions in terms of content and knowledge? How quickly was the contestant able to think on her feet? How articulate and personable was she?



FITNESS/SWIM

Judging Criteria: Confidence, Choice of Ensemble, Poise, Posture and Execution of Movement will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be thinking about during this segment of the competition: How well did the contestant model her athletic wear/swimsuit in terms of style and grace? How well did the contestant's athletic wear/swimsuit flatter her figure? How well did the contestant convey confidence?

EVENING GOWN

Judging Criteria: Confidence, Poise, Posture, Personality, Charm, Style, Charisma, Grace, Execution, Overall Appearance and Stage Presence will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be thinking about during the Evening Gown Competition. How well did the contestant model her gown in terms of technique and elegance? How well did the contestant's gown flatter her figure? How well did the contestant convey confidence?

Judging Criteria: Knowledge, Spontaneity, Personality, Vocabulary, Voice, Confidence, and Sense of Values will be evaluated. Here are some of the questions the Judges will be considering during the On-Stage Interview Competition: How well did the contestant answer the question in terms of content and knowledge? How quickly was the contestant able to think on her feet? How articulate and personable was she?

PATRIOTIC WEAR

Judging Criteria: Creativity of Costume, Modeling Execution, Personality and Stage Presence A winner will be named in each division and will be presented with an award. This competition has no bearing on the overall outcome of the pageant.

Documents & Backstage

DOCUMENTS AND DEADLINES

- 1. Official Application Due Immediately
- 2. Deposit Due within 24 hours of titleholder offer
- 3. Official Paperwork Due within 24 hours of deposit
 - Titleholder Agreement
 - Copy of Driver's License/Birth Certificate
 - MRS Copy of marriage license
 - MS Final divorce decree for any previously married contestants
 - Credit Card Authorization Form (Only used if in violation of contract or on delinquent accounts)
- 4. Headshot, professional photo, NO sash and crowns allowed
- 5. Ad Page artwork/fees/forms (as soon as they are ready, but NO LATER than one month prior to the pageant)
- 6. Judges Bio due NO LATER than one month prior to the pageant
- 7. Any other documents requested by the director.

DEADLINE FOR ALL REQUESTED PAPERWORK TO BE ANNOUNCED

BACKSTAGE RULES

No one is allowed in the backstage dressing area before, during, or after the pageant other than the contestant. We will have staff backstage to help with wardrobe if necessary.





Pageant Etiquette

ETIQUETTE

None of these things will win or lose a pageant for you. However, once you have entered the pageant everyone is watching you, and it is important to make a good impression. These guidelines will help you create an impression of a responsible, confident, organized individual who can handle any job given to her.

- Meet every deadline, or call for an extension!
- Follow all rules! They are for your safety and security.
- Be neat and clean! No one should have to pick up after you.
- Be organized! It is your responsibility to know what's happening and be ready.
- Get acquainted! You should get to know the other contestants, the contestant coordinators, and our Team. Most importantly, be respectful to everyone!
- Be complimentary of all accommodations and meals! Sponsors and staff always do their best, please remember that.
- Be cheerful even if you are not "the winner." Only one person can win the crown, and you are a winner for representing your local title!
- Be a gracious winner! It happens once in a lifetime, and many others would like to be in your shoes!

FAQ's

Do I have to compete in and win a preliminary competition in order to compete in the national pageant?

Yes, Pennsylvania has a state competition that you must compete in order to go to the national pageant. Other states may or may not have local preliminaries available in your area, if there is not a preliminary pageant in your state apply directly with the national office.

How long does it take to receive my sash and crown?

Once the sash is ordered it generally takes 4-6 weeks for production.

When do tickets go on sale?

Tickets typically go on sale 2-4 weeks prior to the pageant. You will be notified when they go on sale and given instructions on how to purchase tickets.

Does everyone need a ticket to the pageant?

Yes! Everyone over the age of 2 needs a ticket.

Are there any required rehearsals?

No. All rehearsals take place pageant weekend.

Will the pageant be televised?

The State Pageant can be seen via Livestream. More information will be announced as we get closer to the pageant.

Will I get a Facebook page or Instagram account for my_local title?

DO NOT CREATE ANY SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNTS WITH YOUR LOCAL USOA TITLE. You will be provided a Division Facebook page for you to use for your reign. Local titleholders no longer get Instagram accounts, but you are free to use your account

How do I sell advertisements in the program book to raise money towards my pageant expenses?

Once you are registered as a contestant, you will be provided a sponsorship letter to present to businesses, friends and family whom may wish to support you by either purchasing an advertisement to simply wish you good luck or to promote and highlight their business!
